# VIVEKANANDA MISSION

## MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

*Registered under Act XXI of 1860 of the Governor-General of India  
in Council.*

---

1. The name of the Society is the VIVEKANANDA MISSION.
2. The Registered office of the Society will be situated in Calcutta, but the Society may have branches both in and outside Calcutta.
3. The objects of the Society are :—
  - (a) The study and practice of the principles of the Vedanta including the essential principles of all religions.
  - (b) The imparting and spread of education in all its phases as defined by Swami Vivekananda, *viz.*, "Education is the manifestation of the perfection already in man", and to establish and maintain institutions with that object.
  - (c) The spread of the ideals and teachings of Swami Vivekananda.
  - (d) The service of man regarding such service as the service of divinity.
  - (e) Acceptance of any gift or endowment unconditionally or subject to any condition that may be approved of by the Executive Committee of the Society.
  - (f) The raising and holding of funds for purposes of the Society.

- (g) The investment of the funds of the Society in such manner as the Executive Committee may consider to be for the benefit of the Society and for such benefit to convert or alter such investments at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- (h) The purchase of property for the Society and the sale, charge or mortgage of any property belonging to the Society.
- (i) The grant of or taking on lease of any property for purposes of the Society.
- (j) Borrowing money or entering into any liability for purposes of the Society, and securing the payment or discharge of any debt or liability by mortgage, charge, pledge, hypothecation or assignment of any property of the Society in such manner as the Executive Committee may deem fit and proper.
- (k) Co-operation or collaboration with any institution or person in any work within the scope of the objects of the Society.
- (l) The establishment of branches.
- (m) Allowing affiliation to branches and other institutions intending to work under the guidance of the Society.
- (n) The printing and publication of such books, journals, periodicals, pamphlets and leaflets as the Executive Committee may think fit.
- (o) The doing of all such things as are directly or indirectly necessary or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Society or any of them.

#### MANAGEMENT OF TRUST ENDOWED.

4. The income received by the Society or accruing from any property belonging to the Society shall be applied solely towards the

maintenance of the Society or the promotion of all or any of the objects of the Society and no portion thereof shall be applied or paid directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus or profit to any person as a member of the Society.

5. If upon dissolution of the Society there shall remain after discharge of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society, but shall be transferred to some other society or institution having objects similar or of a like nature to those of the Society, such transfer to be determined by the votes of not less than  $\frac{3}{5}$ ths of the members of the Society assembled at an Extraordinary General Meeting to be called for the purpose. In default of such meeting, the question as to how such property is to be applied shall be decided by a Judge of the High Court of Judicature at Fort William in Bengal.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**OF THE**  
**VIVEKANANDA MISSION**

1. There shall be two classes of members—Life members and Ordinary members :—

(a) Life members are those that are admitted according to the rules of the Society and pay an admission fee of Rs. 2/- each and a contribution at one time of Rs. 100/- each.

(b) Ordinary members may either be lay or monastic. Monastic members consist of Sannyasis or Brahmacharis. Lay members are those that are not Sannyasis or Brahmacharis. Monastic members are exempted from payment of any admission fee or subscription. Lay members pay an admission fee of Rs. 2/- and a subscription of not less than four annas per month. But the Society may at its Annual General Meeting exempt any ordinary member from payment of any admission fee or subscription. Ordinary members are admitted according to the rules of the Society.

(c) Persons accepting the aims and objects of the Society and desiring of being admitted as members of the Vivekananda Mission shall apply in a prescribed form, being proposed by one and seconded by another member, the applications being decided by the Executive Committee. Such decision shall be subject to revision by members assembled in General Meeting.

2. Foundation members are those whose names are set out in Schedule A hereto.

3. (a) For the first 5 years the office-bearers of the Vivekananda Mission will be elected from amongst the foundation members.

(b) Two-thirds of the members of the Executive Committee, including the office-bearers, will be elected from amongst the foundation members or members of at least 3 years standing and the remaining one-third may be elected from amongst all members.

4. Any member not paying his subscription to the Society for twelve consecutive months shall cease to be a member of the Society.

5. Any member against whom a complaint in writing duly signed by one or more members is made that his connection with the Society is likely to injure the Society and its work, may be removed by the Society assembled in General Meeting by the vote of at least two-thirds of the members present at such meeting, after consideration of the complaint. At such meeting the member against whom the complaint is made is entitled to be present and to defend himself, should he desire to do so.

6. The office-bearers of the Society shall consist of the following :—

- (a) ONE PRESIDENT.
- (b) THREE VICE-PRESIDENTS.
- (c) ONE SECRETARY.
- (d) TWO ASSISTANT SECRETARIES.
- (e) ONE TREASURER.

7. The management of the Society shall be vested in the Executive Committee composed of not less than 20 and not more than 30 members. The President, the Vice-Presidents, the Secretary, the Assistant Secretaries, and the Treasurer shall be *ex-officio* members of the Executive Committee.

8. The election of office-bearers and of the other members of the Executive Committee shall take place at every alternate Ordinary Annual General Meeting. The office-bearers and the other members of the Executive Committee shall hold office until the appointment of their successors. Any vacancy occurring amongst the office-bearers or amongst the other members of the Executive Committee before the next election shall be filled up by the Executive Committee.

9. There shall be an Ordinary Annual General Meeting in the month of April in every year, at which the following business will be transacted :—

- (a) Submission and consideration of the report of the working of the Society during the previous year.
- (b) The consideration and the passing of the audited accounts and the balance sheet of the previous year.
- (c) The election in every alternate year of the office-bearers and of the members of the Executive Committee.
- (d) The appointment of Auditors.

10. Ordinary Annual General Meetings of the Society shall be called by the Secretary under the instructions of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will also be at liberty to call Extraordinary General Meetings of the Society for the consideration of such business as the Executive Committee shall deem fit to place before such meeting. Extraordinary General Meetings shall also be called by the Secretary on receipt of a requisition signed by at least 25 members of the Society. Notice of such a meeting shall be given by the Secretary within fifteen days from the receipt of such requisition. If no meeting is called by the Secretary within fifteen days from the receipt of the requisition, the Requisitionists may themselves call the meeting within seven days after the expiry of the said fifteen days. No question shall be considered at meetings called on a requisition except the business stated in the requisition. At least seven days notice shall be given of all General Meetings other than those called on a requisition.

11. The quorum for a General Meeting shall be 15 and that for a meeting of the Executive Committee shall be 5.

12. There shall be five Trustees of the Society from amongst the members of the Society in whom all property of the Society shall be vested. The first Trustees shall be the following :—

1. SWAMI DHIRANANDA.
2. SWAMI BARADANANDA.

3. SRIJUT GANENDRANATH BANERJI.
4. SRIJUT KIRAN CHUNDER DUTT.
5. SRIJUT JATINDRA NATH BASU.

Any three of the Trustees shall be entitled to exercise all or any of the powers and functions of all the Trustees.

In case of death, resignation, incapacity or removal of any Trustee, the Executive Committee shall appoint a new Trustee in his place.

13. The office-bearers shall have and exercise such power as may be vested in them respectively by the Executive Committee.

14. The Executive Committee shall have power to establish branches of the Society for the purpose of giving effect to all or any of the objects of the Society at such place or places as the Executive Committee shall think desirable, and to affiliate societies or organisations carrying all or any of the objects of this Society.

15. The Executive Committee shall have power to frame bye-laws laying down the duties of the office-bearers, and also laying down rules for schools, libraries and other institutions conducted by the Society and also for the conduct of the business of the Society and of the branches and laying down the rules of affiliation, and fixing the affiliation fees to be paid by the branches and other affiliated institutions as also the nature and extent of the control to be exercised by the Society over branches and affiliated institutions.

16. The Executive Committee may open accounts on behalf of the Society with any Bankers, and such accounts will be operated upon by such office-bearer or office-bearers not exceeding three in number as the Executive Committee shall by resolution decide.

17. The Society shall have a common seal which shall be affixed to Deeds and Agreements to be executed on behalf of the Society before the Secretary, Treasurer and another member of the Executive Committee.
